Thanks to Dr. Paul Tiernan, who partnered in the treatment with implant placement, crafted an incredible soft tissue result. Final restoration was designed with CEREC technology and milled from an IPS Empress CAD Multi A2 block. Incisal and facial cervical characteristics resulted from cut-back and layering with the Esthetic Empress veneer porcelains. The CADStarTM one-step stain and glaze approach completed the final cervical dentin and proximal framing affects. Looking forward to viewing this case in 6 months when things really settle in.
